

The T Alwyn Lloyd Memorial Travelling Scholarship

This fund consists of an annual income of about £3,000 derived from a bequest made to the University of Wales by the late Thomas Alwyn Lloyd LLD FRIBA.

- 1. A Scholarship from the T Alwyn Lloyd Bequest will be awarded annually by UWRET, in case of sufficient merit, by the Welsh School of Architecture. Applicants must possess the degree of BSc in Architectural Studies. More than one Scholarship may be awarded from the income of the fund in any one year.
- 2. The Scholarship will be awarded for achievement in the final examination for the degree of BSc in Architectural Studies.
- 3. The Scholarship, which may be of the value of £2,500¹, must be used by the holder during the duration of the MArch degree course of the University. 75 % of the value of the Scholarship will be paid in advance, the remaining 25 % being paid upon submission of a satisfactory report by the holder.
- 4. The object of the Scholarship is to enable the holder to continue the study of Architecture by means of travel.
- 5. The holder of a Scholarship shall, within three months of qualifying for the degree of MArch, submit a report to UWRET, in a form suitable for publication.
- 6. All publications reporting the results of the studies carried out by a scholar, shall clearly state that the work was made possible by the T Alwyn Lloyd Memorial Travelling Scholarship awarded by UWRET.
- 7. Recommendations for the award of the Scholarship must reach UWRET, University of Wales Registry, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NS, on or before 1 January in each year.

These regulations are formed on the basis of the original bequest. When making an award, Trustees may apply discretion and interpret the bequest for modern times.
